

Sevier County Rodeo Royalty Rules

1. Only one rider per animal will be allowed. Rider does not have to ride same horse all week.
2. Contestants will be required to wear western attire.
3. Horse will be judged on neatness, dispatch, ease, calmness, and speed in which it performs the pattern.
4. Participants must be an experienced rider and able to control the horse at all times.
5. The contestants must be able to complete the pattern without assistance.
6. All Winners from the past year are not allowed to compete in the same category the following year.
7. all contestants must be present Saturday night for the crowning or they forfeit the title.
8. Contestants must ride in the Parade on Friday August 9th
9. Contestants must ride in the Grand-entry both nights of rodeo
10. Judging will be August 3rd at 8:30 a.m. All contestants MUST be there and be by the back gate ready to ride by 8:45 a.m.
11. No refunds on entry fees.
12. Judges decision is final.
